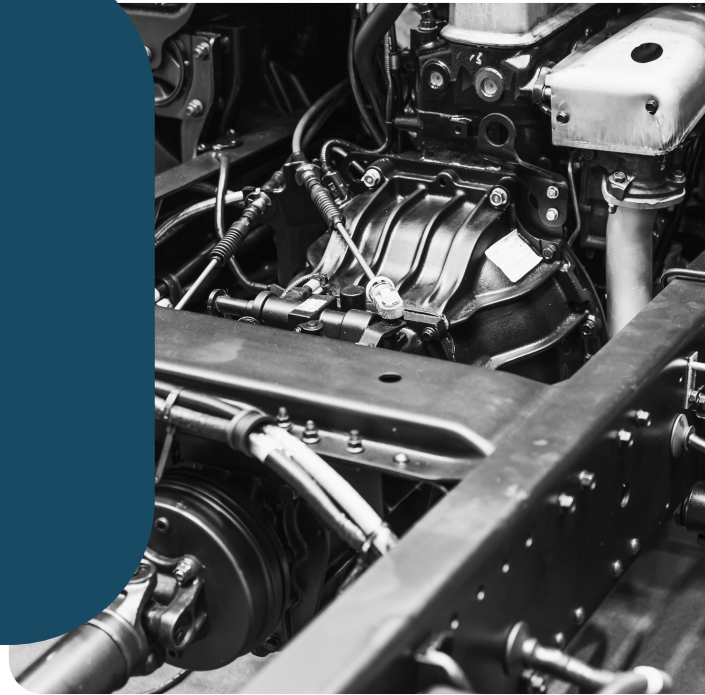

NPN04.13 Trucks (Cab Chassis) is a National Procurement Network arrangement for the supply of New Trucks to Australian Local Governments. This arrangement is due to expire on 31 January 2024, and will be replaced by NPN1.23.

This arrangement provides Queensland, Northern Territory and Tasmanian councils and approved purchasers with access to pre-approved suppliers. It provides streamlined procurement, rather than an open tender for engagement of any value, resulting in significant time and cost savings.
