Disaster Management and Recovery LB505 is a Preferred Supplier Arrangement (PSA as an LGA Arrangement), to support Queensland and Northern Territory councils and other buyers with access to a broad range of disaster recovery management services following the declaration of a natural disaster.

This Arrangement has been aligned to support Queensland councils, State Government entities and other buyers when responding to natural disasters.

The Arrangement is structured to streamline access to funding and support compliance with Queensland Reconstructive Authority (QRA) requirements. The inclusion of QRA references is intended to assist councils and other buyers to align their procurement activities with QRA expectations and to support access to Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

This Arrangement has five (5) categories for the coordination and management of disaster recovery:

1. Coordination of Counter Disaster Operations
2. Coordination of Emergency Works and Emergency Response
3. Disaster Management Consultancy
4. Disaster Management Program Management
5. Disaster Recovery related Grant Writing

Coordination and management excludes the direct delivery of disaster recovery works (e.g. the carrying out of tree lopping services or delivering bridge repairs etc.). These types of works should be directly procured through other Local Buy Arrangements.
